## update to AAT assessments

The AAT has revised the structure of its Audit and Assurance (AUDT) assessment from 16 September 2024.

Previously, the assessment was made up of 42 marks for written elements, and 58 marks for objective test questions.

From 16 September, the revised format will have 30 marks for written elements, and 70 marks for objective test questions. AAT feels this will better test students' understanding and application of audit and assurance principles.

There have been no changes to the specification for this unit.

## updated AAT practice assessments

Students who are sitting the AAT AUDT assessment after 16 September 2024 will need to make sure they access the practice assessments marked 'from 16th Sept 24', to ensure that they are familiar with the revised structure of the assessment.
